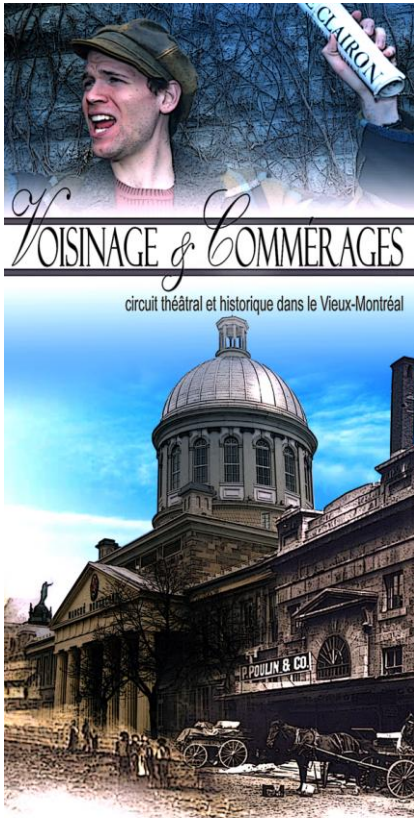


Looking for newspaper carrier...
